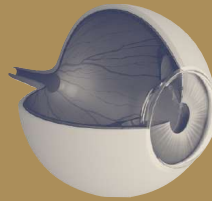


# 61<sup>st</sup> Annual Walter Wright Symposium

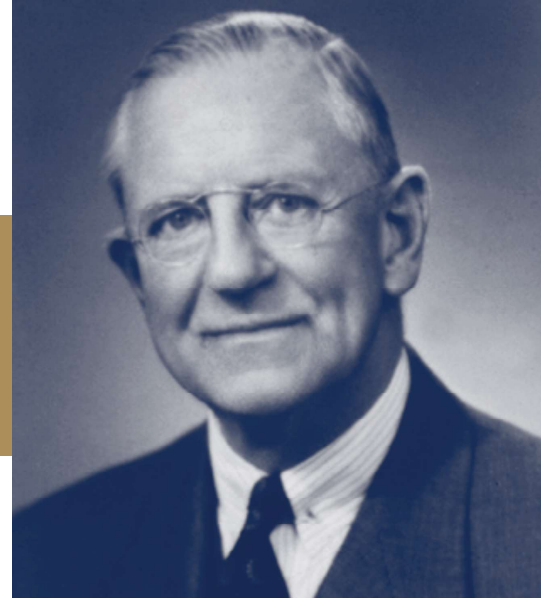

## Diamond \$30,000 +13% HST

- 20' x 20' premium exhibit space

## Platinum \$20,000 +13% HST
