Dialogues in Diversity: Centering EDI in Pediatric Health Research explores how the application of inclusive best practice, and a focus on the social determinants of health, is essential to highlight issues of disparity and develop inclusive frameworks that increase access, remove structural barriers and improve health outcomes for all.

Systemic and structural barriers in health care systems continue to impact healthcare and patient outcomes. In order to address these inequities and implement practical and sustainable approaches to mitigate them, stakeholders at all levels (students, trainees, faculty, clinicians, researchers, and administrators) must develop a strong understanding of what the barriers and their consequences are, and the knowledge and insight to develop tools to address them in their day to day medical research and clinical practice.

Precision Health Care: Bringing Health Equitable Outcomes into Focus

The conversation will explore issues of genetic discrimination and how models of precision health have the potential to transform the healthcare experience in Canada. The conversation will also examine how data governance can be used to effectively tackle social, economic and policy issues, which have historically marginalized equity-seeking groups
