ASSESSING STUDY CREDITS

1 >> ACCREDITATION

Program planners should find the following information helpful when submitting their programs for approval and study credits.

The following activities are...

eligible for study credits:

- ✓ Open Forums with experts may be counted if professional/scientific content is discussed
- ✓ Question and Answer periods
- ✓ Panel Discussions
- ✓ Breakfast, Luncheon, or Dinner with speaker may be counted less the scheduled time for meal
- ✓ Moderated poster sessions that are combined with a break may be counted less the estimated time for the break
- ✓ Sessions for which speaker is listed, topic to be announced
- ✓ Sessions for which topic is listed, speaker to be announced
- ✓ A limited number of sessions with speaker and topic to be announced
- ✓ A scientific presentation or session that is more than 3 hours in length and has no scheduled break will be assumed to have a 15-minute break

not eligible for study credits:

- ✗ Introductions and Opening Remarks
- ✗ Concluding Remarks
- ✗ Business Meetings
- ✗ Breaks
- ✗ Award Granting Sessions
