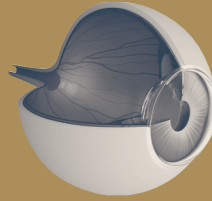


## 59<sup>th</sup> Annual *Walter Wright Symposium*

### **Diamond \$30,000 +13% HST**
